#### WHEN TRUTH OVERRIDES FACTS

God spoiled us by design. But our blessed self is loaded with challenges. This is truth but facts bring a focus to what currently exists and truth brings about hope for the future. God gave us all a purpose.

At Forward Training Center, truth comes alive with every student joining our program. Crisis sometimes allows us to look deeper into what God intended for each of us. It pushes us to grow up. When our students realize who they are they do what comes naturally. Students, both adults and youth, need the ability to see the gifts and talents God has endowed them with.

### Change lives by becoming a Volunteer

This opportunity comes alive with their completion of a career assessment. This is the beginning of their roadmap for defining their specific desired occupation. Communication is critical to achieving next steps. Sixty second commercials, about themselves are a key factor in the interview process. Students practice until they feel comfortable with their presentation in the presence of the entire class. Resumes are essential to getting you



in the door for interviews. Instructors stay focused on the completion of a polished document. Mock Interviews come next with community leaders giving of their time to interview each student.

Finally, Career Day brings Granbury Professionals together with the students. Each student has a career identified and the professionals are matched with each students. The relationships are formed for future communication. The seed has been planted and this creates a network for each student and tremendous sense of value.

We have many different opportunities to serve within our Jobs for Life and Powered for Life (Youth) programs.

Our next Jobs for Life class starts March 22, 2022 and meets on Tuesday and Thursday from 10:00 am until noon for 8 weeks. Powered for Life meets within the GISD annual school year on Monday through Thursday for 6 weeks.
